27. Futurity Class

This class a guide as to how well you predict your stock as they develop from kids to maturity.

We have all heard judges say that “this goat shows potential and I’d love to see her develop”.

Judges will award your animal points against the standard.

Scores are totalled at the next Stawell Show Vic, run every 12mths.

The judge does not reveal the animals scores on the day of the show.

The Steward will collect scores to be transferred to a database until the final Futurity Show.

Entrants must attend a minimum of three shows to be eligible to compete at the finale in Stawell Vic each year where the winner is announced.

All MGA registered animals from any breed and of any gender (wethers excluded) that are under 12 months of age at the date of the Stawell Show, being 30th April 2022, are eligible to enter.

Class cost is \$20.00 per goat.
