PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE COMPLETING THIS CERTIFICATE

1. The correct way to measure a goat is to have it standing squarely on a flat even surface (concrete is best). Measurement is to be taken from the ground in a line to the highest point of the wither and no further back than the point of the elbow. The animal should be standing with all legs in a vertical line to the ground. It should be as relaxed as possible and standing with its head in the natural upright position (as pictured). It is best if hooves are neatly trimmed.
2. The animal must be measured with the approved Miniature Goats Australia Association Inc. Piccolo measuring tool.
3. A clear photo showing the animal and the animals height on the measuring tool (including bubble of the spirit level on top), as shown above is also required. An adult photo of the goat by itself **MUST** also be forwarded with this form for adult registration. Photos will be uploaded into the MGA database.
4. **Fees - FREE** if 1 & 2 year heights have been submitted **OR** \$15.00 otherwise (see Admin Charge Sheet)
