

Miniature Goats Australia Association Inc. Photo Requirements Guide

Registrations and 3 Year Up grades require one good quality PHOTO with each submission.

Please reduce photos before sending via Email or text to 500 x 500 Pixels, 600x500 or 800x600 are also ok. Please do not send anything over 1000. Mostly if you right click on the photo and use the send to 'mail recipient' if emailing, your software will ask if you want to reduce the size.

Please be aware – download and uploads can be costly and our registrar/s pay for their data usage and donate freely to our Association. Large files, in particular photos, overload their data usage.

REDUCING FILES SIZE AND CROPPING PHOTOS FOR MGA REGISTRATIONS.

Click the pause button to allow the video to buffer fully before watching, this saves the video starting and stopping while trying to view it.

- a) Only the animal in question should be clearly seen in the photo, side on preferably looking the camera,
- b) Please photograph the whole animal including feet, ears and tail,
- c) The animal must be photographed in good condition,
- d) Printed photos must be clear and taken in good light, please print animals name on the back,
- e) Emailed photos should be correctly named, either in subject line or the file itself,
- f) Photos should be recent,
- g) Photos are for Registration Certificates and represent your stud and MGA so please take pride in your photos and only send in the very best you can, ensure they are taken in good light. Having an assistant will make the task easier.
- h) Registrar/s will sometimes need to reject photos they think are not suitable.
- i) Please remember to take photos prior to selling as it is the sellers responsibility to provide a registration photo.
